DUES: Payment is due January 31, except as noted. No one will be allowed to row or use club equipment until dues have been paid. See reverse for additional explanation of membership categories:

- ___ **General Membership** (*runs on calendar year basis, and may be prorated at \$85.00 per quarter for those joining for the first time after the first quarter of the year*) \$340.00
- ___ **Junior Membership** (*Full-time student under age 18*) \$225.00
- ___ **College Membership** (*Out-of-state student under age 22 - rowing summer and holidays only*) \$150.00
- ___ **Adaptive Program** (*No dues for **volunteers** rowing only with Adaptive Program--see reverse*) \$75.00
- ___ **Trial Membership** (*One time only, age 18 and over – extends to end of calendar year*) \$170.00
- ___ **Instructional Membership** (*Individuals participating in a club activity who are not already in another recognized membership category—see full description on reverse.*) None

Any exceptions to the dues guidelines are subject to the approval of the Board of Directors. **Make checks payable to Louisville Rowing Club.** Any person may apply for help with dues under a hardship waiver. This is held in confidence and must be submitted for review by the Board of Directors. Arrangements may also be made to pay in installments, with half due by January 31, and the balance due by April 30.

BOAT STORAGE: Boats privately owned by members may be stored in club boathouses, **space permitting**, for a fee. Please contact the Boathouse Manager or a member of the Board to make arrangements for boat storage.

General Membership*\$340.00 per year [Jan 1 to Dec 31]*

As a person applying for or holding GENERAL MEMBERSHIP in the Louisville Rowing Club, you are entitled to full use of club equipment [all equipment you are certified to use] at any time of the day. You must understand and agree to follow the rules set forth by the club.

Junior Membership*\$225.00 per season [May 1 through December]*

As a person applying for or holding JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP in the Louisville Rowing Club, you must follow all Louisville Rowing Club rules as set forth by the club. In addition, you must follow all of the rules set forth for the Junior Program that is run and/or regulated by the Louisville Rowing Club.

College*\$150.00 per year [Jan 1 to Dec 31]*

As a person applying for or holding COLLEGE MEMBERSHIP in the Louisville Rowing Club, you must agree to comply with club rules. You must be between the ages of 18 and 22 and be enrolled in an out-of-state college full time. You will be allowed to row whenever you are in the Louisville area. Local college teams will be welcome to join through this category during their off season.

Adaptive Program*\$75.00 per year [On-water season runs April to November]*

The classification for ADAPTIVE MEMBERSHIP in the Louisville Rowing Club is offered to persons with disabilities [other rowers must apply for another membership category]. You must agree to comply with all club rules. In addition, you must follow all rules set forth by the Louisville Rowing Club that pertain to this program. This membership is limited to special times and equipment usage. Any person serving as an ADAPTIVE VOLUNTEER shall be provided with the proper instruction in rowing and an orientation to club operations. Any rowing beyond the times scheduled for the Adaptive Program will constitute a General Membership and the rower will be billed for dues in the General Membership category. An Adaptive Volunteer is considered an INSTRUCTIONAL MEMBER.

Trial Members*\$170.00*

Trial membership includes persons 18 and over joining for the first time. This incentive membership will extend until the end of the first calendar year.

Instructional Members*No Fee*

This classification is for an individual engaged in a club activity who does not already belong through another membership category. This category includes those taking and giving lessons, participating in seminars or special club events, rowing as a guest, volunteering in the Adaptive Program, and/or serving as a special coach/coxswain.



Any exceptions to the dues categories must be approved by the Board.

The Louisville Rowing Club is generally a volunteer organization. As the club continues to grow, it will be necessary to rely more and more on the time and talents of our members. Please consider your dues as just a part of your membership. Members will be asked to contribute personal time throughout the year to assist in the operation of the Club, by helping with activities, working on the grounds and equipment, and those important overhead activities such as the Website, mailings, and membership.
